
Project overview

- **More than £3.5 billion investment** in UK electricity infrastructure
- Contributing to the **UK Government's target of 50 gigawatts (GW) of offshore wind installed capacity by 2030**
- **10% of the Scottish Government's ambition of 11GW by 2030**
- Efficient re-use of a **brownfield site** and use of existing **grid capacity** and **transmission infrastructure**
- New facility in Port of Montrose and more than **50 long-term skilled local jobs**
- Set to generate **enough green electricity** to power **half the homes in Scotland**

Project status

- **Contract for difference (CfD)** awarded in 2022 (Award Round 4) and 2024 (Award Round 6)
- Onshore construction work **well underway** at site of former coal-fired Cockenziee Power Station
- Landfall site being ready **first export cable pull in** today. First one third section of cable installed.
- **Offshore substation** installed in August with commissioning ongoing
- First monopiles are **on their way to Leith** from CWHI/Dajin (China)
- **Team of 140** working with contractors on main packages



- Overseeing the storage, handling, and loadout of all project components and equipment with SPMTs, cranes, forklifts, etc.
- (54 monopiles, 54 TPs, 54 pin piles, 18 jackets and more).
- Delivering safe, efficient operations in collaboration with the Inch Cape project team for all base scope and additional works as required.

Forth Ports are also the **WTG Pre-assembly port** at the **Port of Dundee**. Primary scope will be the turbine OEM's.


